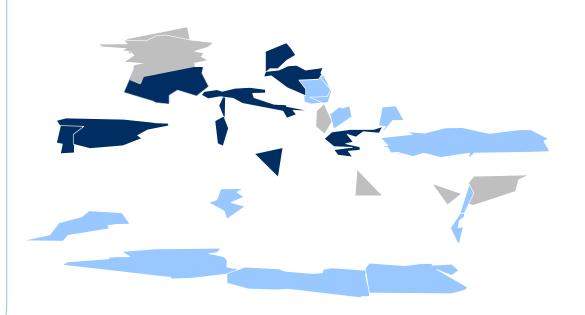


Geographical boundaries of the study

Definition of mediterranean wines

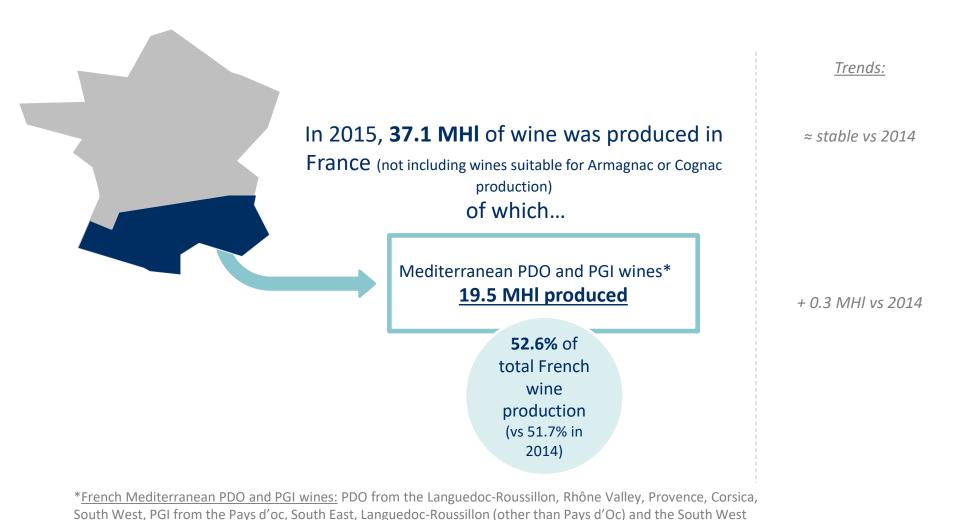
- EU countries: only PDO and PGI wines
- Non EU countries: all domestically produced wines
- Zones not covered by the study



Methodology: Delineating the geographical scope for France

France covers PDO and PGI wines produced in the south of France - namely 52.6% of French wine production in 2015 (51.7% in 2014)





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Context: The production of Mediterranean wines

Mediterranean wines are increasing market share: in 2015, they represented 28.7% of global wine production, compared to 26.9% in 2014



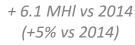
Trends:

+ 6 MHl vs 2014 (+2% vs 2014)





Mediterranean <u>countries</u> produced **139 MHI** of wine, **50.4%** (vs 49.3% in 2014) of global production

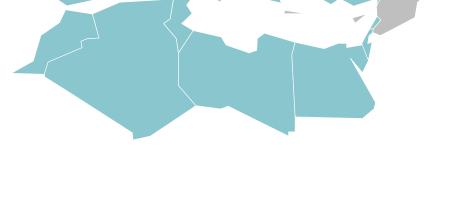

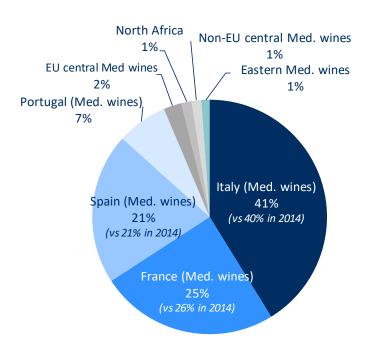
Production: Share of volume by source country

Italy, France and Spain remain dominant. The majority of other Mediterranean zones have seen levels increase by double-digits

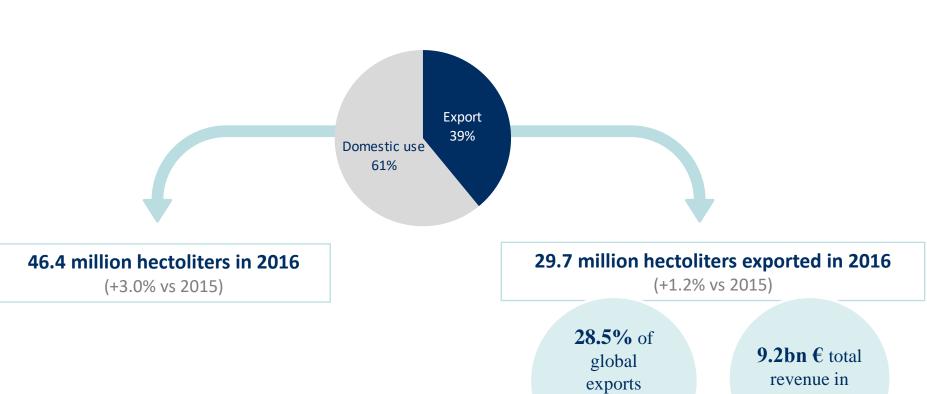

Mediterranean wines: Where are they sold?

In 2016 29.7 million hectoliters of Mediterranean wines were exported – 28.5% of which were global exports (compared to 27.8% in 2015)



Total commercial output from production of Mediterranean wines in 2015/16: **76.1 million hectoliters** (+2.3% vs 2014/15)

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Mediterranean wine exports (vol. et val.): still light and sparkling wine Sparkling wine exports increased much faster than those of still light wine, which dropped in terms of volume

Mediterranean wine exports (vol. et val.): Markets In 2016, exports to Non-EU countries increased by 7%. At the same time, exports within the EU dropped by 2.1%

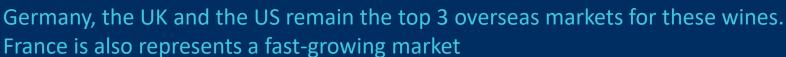

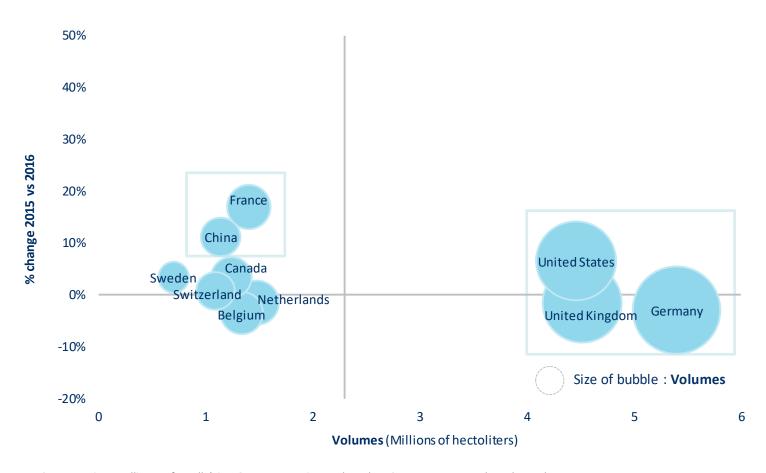

In millions of hectoliters



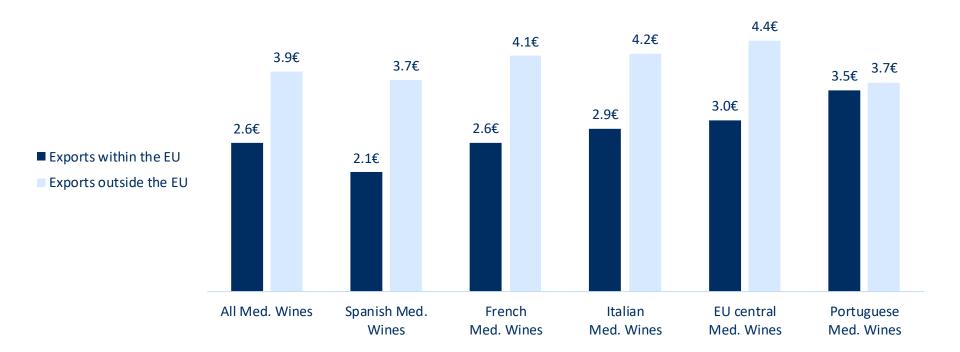
Mediterranean wine exports: Average value per market

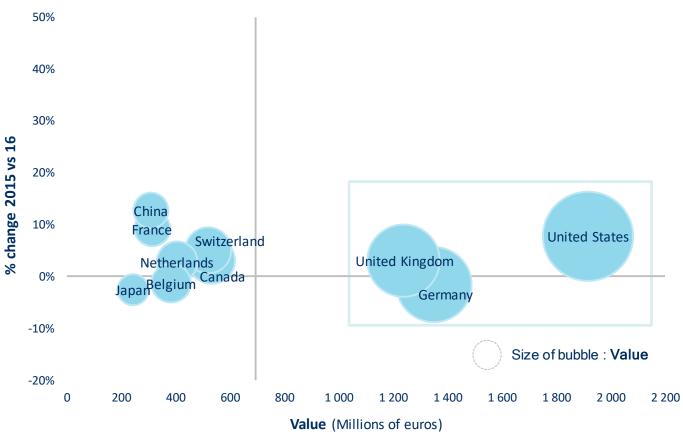

Mediterranean wine exports(VALUE): Top 10 export markets in 2016



The US is the main market for Mediterranean wines in terms of value. It's also one of the fastest growing markets (along with France and China)

Export markets for Mediterranean wines: top 10 in value (2016) and % change since 2015 In millions of euros



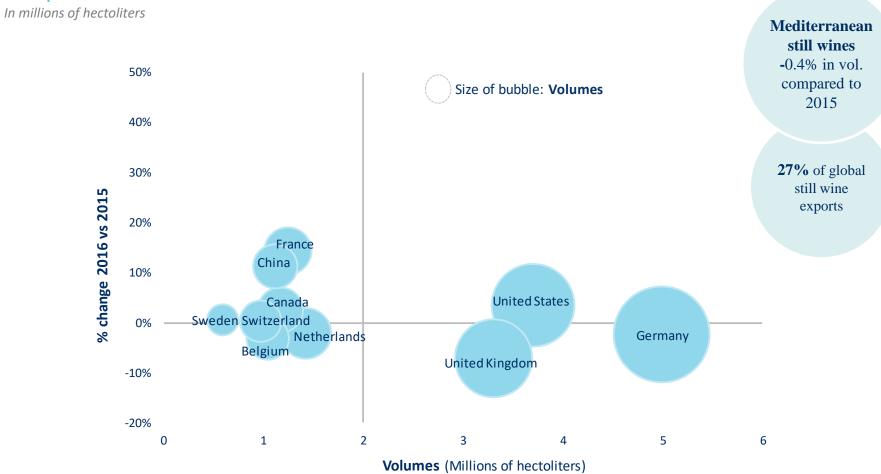


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Mediterranean wine exports: Focus on still wines (volumes) In slight decline (-0.4% vs 2015) overall; fast-growing export markets (USA, France, China, Canada) sit alongside those in decline (UK, Germany, Belgium, The Netherlands)

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Mediterranean sparkling wine exports: Top 10 export markets



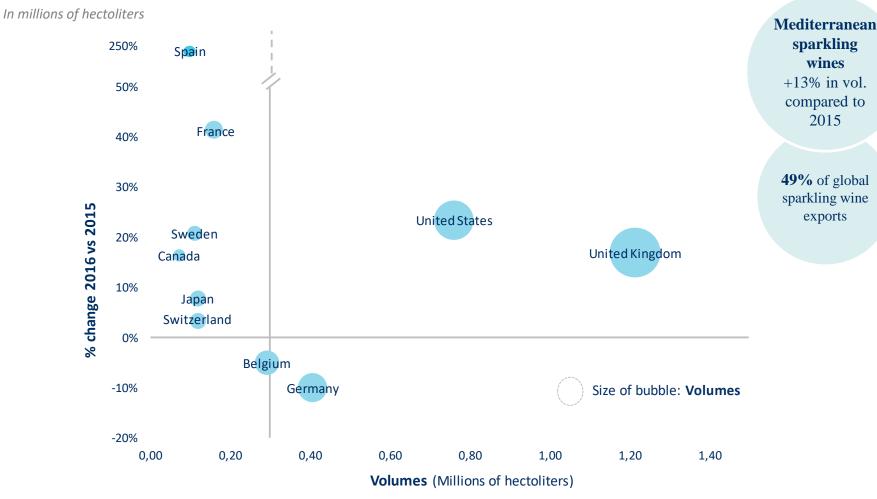

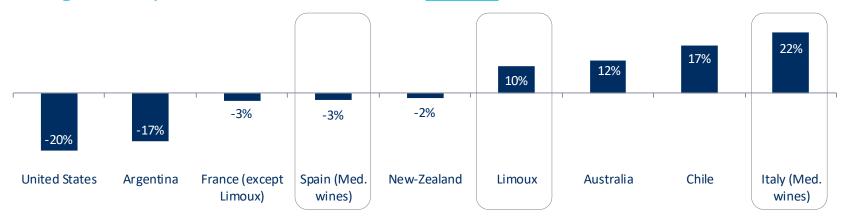
Export markets for Mediterranean sparkling wines: top 10 in volume (2016) and % change 2016 vs 2015



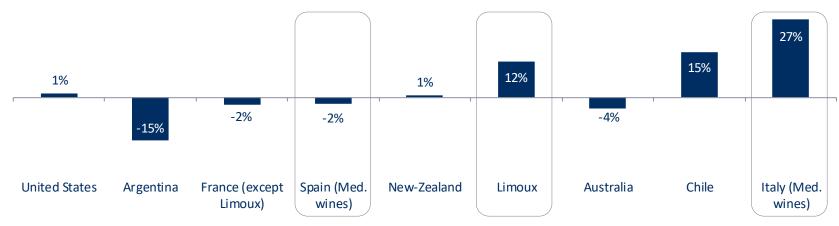
Sparkling wine exports: Mediterranean wines vs competitors Italian sparkling wines have shown impressive growth: in 2016, they increased by 22% in volume and 27% in terms of value

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Focus on French Mediterranean wines: volume and value 2016 Provence continues to increase at a steady rate (+22% in vol.) and has become the PDO with the highest export value (5.9€ p/litre). There are also significant increases in value from the Languedoc-Roussillon PDO wines (+10% between 2015 and 2016)

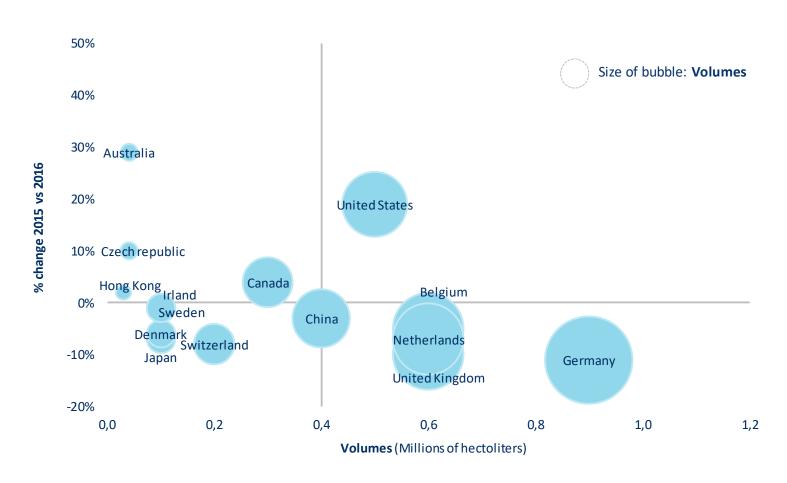

Focus on French Mediterranean wines: Top 10 export markets EU countries are still in decline whereas the US and Canada are the principal growth drivers. Also significant is the increase in exports to Australia (from a small base)

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Conclusions



- 1. The influence of Mediterranean wines continues to increase in global business
- 2. Export markets outside the EU are growing three times faster than those in the EU
- 1. The US and China continue to boost Mediterranean wine exports (+6% et +11% in volume respectively)
- 2. Mediterranean wines are becoming more premium. Total export revenue increased by 4% in 2016, to 9.2 billion Euros.
- 3. Sparkling wines are the growth driver of Mediterranean wine exports. Between 2015 and 2016, the Mediterranean still wine exports were in slight decline (-0.4%), whereas sparkling wines increased by 13% (in volume)
- French Mediterranean wine exports :
 - The decline of mature European markets is intensifying (sharp drops in Germany, The Netherlands, in Belgium and the UK)
 - The US is becoming a more important market (+19% volume in 2016)
 - Export revenue of French Mediterranean wines continues to rise
 - Provence continues to make progress at a steady rate (+22% in volume) and has become the region with the highest export value (5.9€ p/liter).
 - Apart from Provence, the French PDO wines and PGI wines have lost export volume but have seen gains in terms of value (in particular PDO wines from the Languedoc-Roussillon, +10% for their average price)



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
